Frequently Asked Questions

Are children welcome on board?

Yes they are, but they must be at least 10 years old to go with you on a charter. It can get quite fast, loud and cold when out at sea at top speed.

Where do we start our trip?

Your trip will begin in Portsmouth Historic Dockyard, a representative of PNBPT will greet you at the main entrance and take you to the Pontoon.

How fast will I get to go?

We usually get to around 30 knots on a charter.

How many people can go on a trip?

HSL 102 can take up to nine passengers.

Do you provide life jackets?

Yes we do, we only have two that would fit children though so please do bear this in mind. Passengers will not be allowed on the boat without a lifejacket.

Do we need to crew the boat?

No, we provide all necessary crew and a Skipper. All we would like you to do is enjoy yourselves and make sure that you do as the Skipper says for your own safety.

Is there easy access on to the boat?

You will be required to step from the Pontoon onto the boat. You will be assisted but if you have any concerns that you or someone from your group will not be able to do this then please do contact us and we will be able to advise further.

What should I wear?

Primarily warm clothes as it can get very cold, especially when we are travelling at speed. Please do not wear a skirt—the lifejackets have crotch straps! We suggest you bring a waterproof jacket, a hat, and that you wear soft soled shoes that lace up so that they aren't loose. If it is sunny please ensure that you wear sunscreen as it is easy to get a little sun-burnt when on the water!

HSL 102, commissioned in 1936, is the only 100 class high speed launch to survive. Capable of a speed of up to 40 knots, HSL 102 together with her fellow launches, rescued more than 13000 airmen from the sea.
